**PASTORAL ADMINISTRATOR'S REMARKS** SR Joan

- CMA at 77.62%; \$34,990.01 pledged, approximately \$10,000 to go. Parish is in top 25% of the Diocese. Diocesan goal is 5.7 million / \$3,977,855 has been pledged or 69.58% of goal
- Retaining Wall has been replaced
- On Jan. 4<sup>th</sup>, 18 youth will celebrate Confirmation at the Cathedral
- Wed. Dec. 7<sup>th</sup> at 7pm / Father George will present Infancy Narratives
- Sr. Joan will continue past June as Pastoral Administrator (2 years max)
